REQUEST FOR DRIVERS TO PAY A PARKING FEE

As previously reported, Karabo Parking has, without warning, increased our monthly parking fee from R1, 600 to a ridiculous R5, 000; with effect from 1 June 2019. Consequently, we have an unbudgeted R23, 800 to pay in parking fees (i.e. from June to Dec 2019). We therefore ask parishioners who own cars to please contribute R100 each on a monthly basis; starting from 1 July 2019. Please use an EFT (with the reference: Parking Fee) or a speedpoint machine.

PARISH EXPENSES

To keep the Cathedral expenses to a minimum we ask that parishioners donate items of household goods such as photocopy paper (Typek), Communion wine and wafers, toilet rolls, dishwashing liquid, tea, coffee, sugar and milk etc. to the church. We would like to thank those who have already demonstrated their generosity in this regard.
